The contest is over...what now?

The first thing to do is to get your log into proper shape for submission. It must be in 'cabrillo' format for the RSGB 80m CC. Look at your screen, there should be this window, see Fig 1 below



1. Click on 'File' and a drop-down will appear. Select 'Export Cabrillo file' and select where you want it to go and also name it. I usually send it to the desktop and call it something like G3XSD27Feb20 so that I can store it in an orderly way (in a folder called 'Logs') after I have submitted it. Having done this open up a browser and go to <https://www.rsgbcc.org/hf/> You will see a contest list. The contest you are interested in will have 2 buttons 'upload' and the contest list the 'uploaded'. Click on 'upload' see Fig 2 below
